VINEYARDS

Sourced from 1986 & 1998 plantings in the Adelaide Hills. The vineyards consist of soils that are clay over ironstone. The clones planted in the vineyard are D4V12, D5V12, Mariafield clones 115 & 777. The yields are between 1.5 to 2 tonnes to the acre.

WINEMAKING

Twenty five percent of the Pinot fruit was whole bunch fermented by natural yeasts. No enzymes, acid or yeast was added. Pigeage was carried out daily for 3-4 weeks. It was left on full solids and malo occurred in barrel.

OAK TREATMENT

The wine was matured in ten percent new French oak and 90% 2-4 year old french oak for 16 months.

TASTING NOTES

Powerful and muscular wine that has impressive depth of fruit and structure. Yet, on the nose, it is quite ethereal and silky. Extremely generous. Soft and long, with hints of red cherry, forest floor and spicy fruit that lead into an amazing finish.
