The case for savagnin (initially thought to be albarino) grows ever stronger, for it is a wine with real character and substance, its relationship with gewurztraminer no surprise. The texture is rich, and the citrus/lychee flavours long and persistent. Given that all the plantings are recent, even more character should come once the vines are more than 10 years old.
